



"The House and Senate appear to be on a collision course over fiscal 2024 spending, while pressure builds in the Senate for an emergency supplemental bill for defense, disaster relief and more."

- Senate writing spending bills to Fiscal Responsibility Act (FRA) level
- House writing spending bills to \$119 billion less than the FRA level
- FY 24 Deadlines: October 1, January 1, April 30
