Accrual Challenges

- Community NCORPs see less emphasis on accrual
- Decreased expectation numbers
- Fewer trials approved for common cancers
- Variable credit by NCORP
- Physician time commitment continues to increase
- Funding/accrual

Protocol Changes

- Targeted therapy trials with selective eligibility
- Built in treatment initiation delay
- Trial complexity requires additional research personnel training
- Increase in credentialing

New Initiatives

- Cancer Care Delivery Research
 - -- Unknown protocol design
 - -- Infrastructure issues
 - -- Protocol review process
 - -- Hospital buy in
 - -- Staff training
- Minority recruitment reinvigoration
- Barriers to clinical trial access

NCTN Changes Potentially impacting the NCORPs

- Accrual minimums
 - -- Affiliation adjustments possible
 - -- Questionable role for smaller institutions
- Requests for more community participation
- Protocol standardization across groups expected
- Audit standardization would be appreciated

Regulatory Issues

- Central IRB new to some NCORPs
- Generation of new membership lists
- New site codes
- Reimbursement for study specific tests/pathology, etc
 - -- More complex procedures
 - -- Reimbursement delays on some studies
