- 2) Recommend new strategic priorities and directions for the NCTN based on the current portfolio, evolving clinical needs, and emerging scientific opportunities.
- 3) Review and assess the CTWG Evaluation process and results
 - Quality of completed trial outcomes
 - Operational performance of Scientific Steering Committees
 - Efficiency of clinical trial conduct
- 4) Provide strategic advice to enhance NCTN clinical trial operations including collaboration and timeliness.
