NCTN RFA Renewal Evaluation Working Group (WG) Rationale and Purpose

- An external NCTN evaluation is needed as part of the NCTN RFA renewal concept review package for SPL and BSA
 - Assess whether the scientific contributions of the NCTN support RFA reissuance
 - Develop recommendations for enhancing the scientific and operational functioning of the NCTN
- Given the large investment in the NCTN, NCI recommends the external review be conducted under the auspices of CTAC

NCTN RFA Renewal Evaluation Distinctive Features

Evaluation of the NCTN for purposes of the RFA renewal is distinct from the strategic clinical trial portfolio assessment performed by the CTSA Working Group

- Provides a snapshot in time for progress since the issuance of the restructuring RFA (March 2014)
- Focused specifically on the overall scientific output of the NCTN Network
- Provides input on how the RFA might be modified for the next round including Network infrastructure, operations and overall scientific output

Implementation NCTN RFA Renewal Evaluation Working Group

- Convened Fall 2016
- Membership Categories
 - CTAC members
 - Cancer Center Directors
 - Biostatisticians
 - Patient Advocate
- Membership Exclusions
 - NCTN Members in leadership positions
- Deliberations conducted October/November 2016
- Results reported to CTAC March 2017

Proposed Process and Timeline

- July 2016: CTAC approval of an NCTN RFA Renewal Evaluation WG
- Summer 2016: Identification of WG chair and members
- July October 2016: Information compiled for the WG by NCI staff
- September October 2016: WG orientation and review of compiled information
- October/November 2016: In person WG meeting
- December 2016 early February 2017: WG tasks completed
- March 2017: WG report presented to CTAC
