Purpose of the Clinician Scientist Research Award (R50)

- Outstanding clinical investigators at academic institutions carry out activities that are critical to the success of NCI clinical trials.
- Clinical duties make it difficult for them to dedicate the necessary time to these activities.
- The R50 provides a career path and stable salary support (up to 40% FTE) for PIs who want to focus on the design and conduct of NCI-funded clinical trials, but who do not seek independent research funding.
- Intended to promote the retention of clinician scientists with significant relevant experience, who have shown evidence of productivity and research excellence in the implementation of NCI-funded clinical trials within their institution.

Clinical Activities in Support of NCI-Funded Trials

- Accrual to NCI-funded clinical trial networks
- Development of national trials
- Leadership in NCI networks, such as the NCTN/NCORP/ETCTN committees, national or site Principal Investigator of trials, etc.
- Leadership in the institution's clinical trials infrastructure
 - Examples: Directing and participating in activities of the clinical trials office, institutional review board, protocol review, and audit and data safety monitoring committees
- Leadership of the institution's disease- or modality-based groups
- Special activities to ensure the inclusion of underserved populations in the institution's clinical trials
