

Rep. Tom Cole (R-OK) "\$6.5B for Year 1 of ARPA-H "a little fast...why not start more modestly?





#### JUNE OUTLOOK

- President Biden will travel to the UK and Brussels in his first overseas trip to attend the G7 and NATO summits from June 11-14; Biden and Russian President Vladimir Putin will meet on June 16 in Switzerland
- Senate votes on key legislation including the For the People Act and the US Innovation and Competition Act will take place in June
- House Democrats will begin drafting appropriations bills, with subcommittee markups beginning June 24

#### JULY OUTLOOK

- House Speaker Nany Pelosi (D-CA-12) and Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer (D-NY) aim to vote on infrastructure in July
- Monthly child tax credit payments begin on July 15; the credits were expanded under the American Rescue Plan
- Suspension of the debt ceiling is set to expire on July

### **Science and Technology Innovation Bills**

(Goal: Enhance U.S. ability to compete with China)



- Senate recently passed Sen. Majority Leader Chuck Schumer's (D-NY) "U.S. Innovation and Competition Act" (S. 1260)
  - Designed to boost R&D in the U.S.
  - \$81B for NSF FY22-26 (including a new tech directorate), DARPA, DOE/National Labs, NASA, and Commerce Dept regional technology hubs
  - Over \$50 billion for the U.S. Semiconductor industry
  - NIH-Relevant Amendments: Foreign Influence, Gain of Function Research
- Does NOT have a clear path forward in the House (companion legislation stalled)



- This week, House will mark up two competing bills, both introduced by Rep. Eddie Bernice Johnson (D-TX-30), Chair of the House Committee on Science, Space & Technology
  - <u>H.R. 2225</u> National Science Foundation for the Future Act
  - <u>H.R. 3593</u> Department of Energy Science for the Future Act

### **Telehealth Proposals**

- <u>H.R. 366</u> Protecting Access to Post-COVID–19 Telehealth Act
- <u>H.R. 341</u> Ensuring Telehealth Expansion Act
- <u>S.57 /H.R. 596</u>– Advancing Connectivity during the Coronavirus to Ensure Support for Seniors (ACCESS) Act

- <u>S. 368/H.R. 1332</u> Telehealth Modernization Act
- <u>S. 168</u> Temporary Reciprocity to Ensure Access to Treatment "Treat" Act
