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Background

- Clinical trials are the most important and reliable means available to provide scientific evidence for effective care and management of patients with cancer and individuals at risk for cancer.
- Clinical trials should provide evidence that is both valid and generalizable to all populations.
- Individuals of diverse populations need access to embark upon a journey into clinical trials for improved outcomes for themselves and others.
- Diverse enrollment is a major aim of national research policies


