### Appropriations Status – FY 2011

#### What Has Already Happened

- > President's Budget announced Feb. 1
- ➤ NIH \$32.09 Billion; NCI \$5.26 Billion
- > Senate action (S 3686)
  - ✓ Passed by Subcommittee July 27
  - ✓ Passed/reported by full Committee July 29
  - ✓ NIH \$32.01 Billion; NCI \$5.26 Billion
- > House action
  - ✓ Subcommittee passed July 15
- > CR passed through Dec. 3



### Appropriations – What's Next?

Lame Duck Session begins Nov. 15 – then what?

- > Pass individual appropriations bills
- Pass omnibus bill
- > Pass short CR; work on early in 2011
- > Pass full year CR

### New Legislation Introduced

#### HR 6224

- 21st Century Cancer Access to Life-Saving Early Detection, Research and Treatment (ALERT) Act
- Introduced by Rep. Lois Capps on Sept 28
- Companion to Senate bill introduced by Kennedy

#### HR 5861

- Cancer Centers Assistance for Renovations and Expansion Act
- Loan program for qualifying cancer centers
- Introduced by Rep. Kilroy (D-OH) on July 26
