Republicans, Democrats at odds over whether to finish up spending bills after the elections



House Appropriations Chairman Tom Cole, R-OK:

Presidential victor will dictate whether the process should be completed in December or wait until next year when they take control. But whomever wins would be better off with a clean slate.

"The idea that we should give them a funding crisis and a potential government shutdown to worry about in the first couple of months, seems to me to be the height of irresponsibility."

NCI Appropriations FY16 – FY24








Proposes major restructuring of NIH, including consolidation of ICs*	Does not address restructuring

Chair Rodgers Unveils Framework for NIH Reform, Requests Stakeholder Input







Rep. Cathy McMorris Rodgers' (R-WA) framework recommends structural and other reforms:

- Proposes consolidation of 27 Institutes and Centers to 15 (NCI, NIMH, and NIA would not be consolidated)
- Calls for a commission to review NIH, provide public reporting, and make recommendations for improvement
- Proposes limiting IC Director terms to five-years, and no more than two, consecutive terms
- Encourages a focus on innovation and public-private partnerships
- Emphasizes financial disclosure, as well as oversight and accountability regarding misconduct and harassment
- Calls for transparency regarding indirect costs, and proposes reform
- Calls for reform of the grants process, including a focus on national security, grantee compliance, and overall priority setting


