- Recognizes and supports outstanding early career clinical investigators at NCI-Designated Cancer Centers who demonstrate a commitment to becoming an academic clinical researcher and supporting the NCI-funded clinical trials enterprise
- Promotes the retention of early career investigators who wish to initiate a career path that focuses on interventional cancer clinical trials and academic clinical research

Overview

- Competitive award; candidates nominated annually by NCI Cancer Center Directors
- Provides salary support for 15% effort annually for 2 years
- Eligibility
 - at least two years post last clinical fellowship
 - no more than six years from initial academic appointment


