# National Cancer Plan



*Describes goals, strategies, and actions needed to end cancer as we know it*

- **Long-term vision** for ending cancer as we know it
- **A framework for collaboration**
- **All-of-government** approach
- **All-of-society** approach
- **Inclusive of everyone**  
(organizations and individuals)
- *Not* a medium-term strategic/action plan
- *Not* confined to research – includes care, advocacy, policy, individual behaviors

- **Monitor progress** toward ending cancer as we know it; share successes and identify gaps

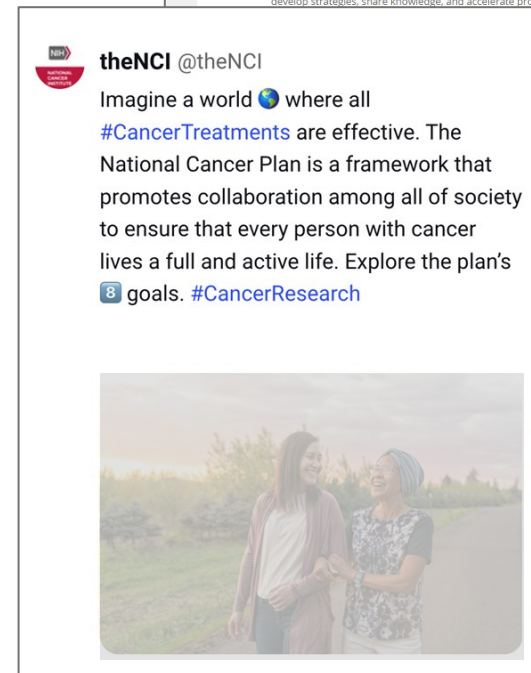
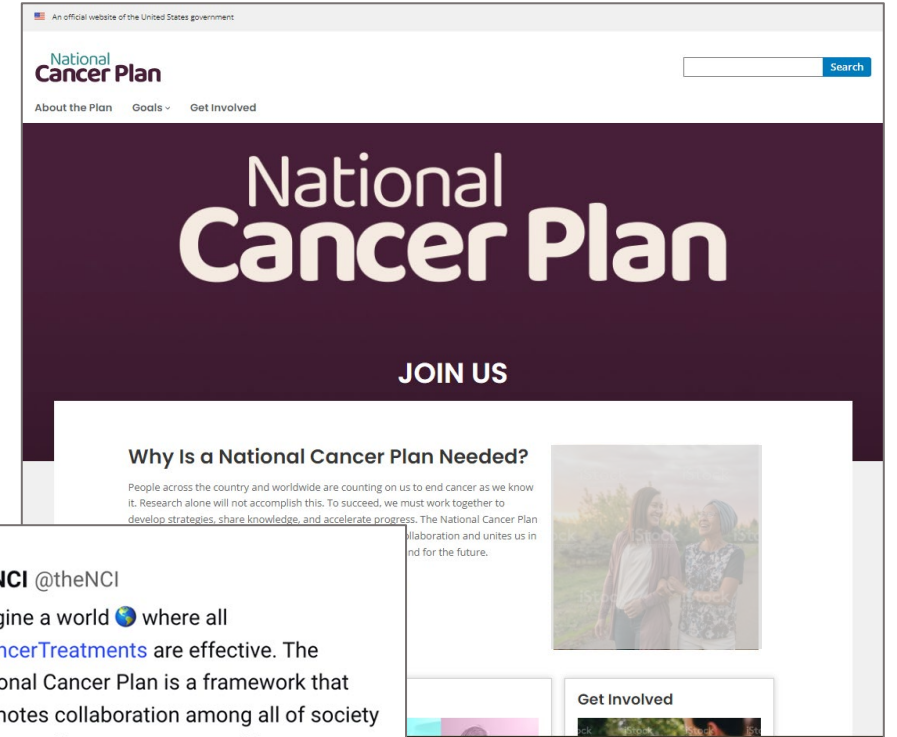
