HR 3010 Conference Report:

- •Adopted by House on December 14, 2005
- •Adopted by Senate on December 21, 2005
- •Signed by President on December 30, 2005 (P.L. 109-149)

Bill Provides:

•NIH: \$28.6 billion

•NCI: \$ 4.8 billion

P.L.109-148: FY2006 Defense Appropriations Act

•Provides a one percent across-the-board rescission to all government appropriations except for the V.A. and emergency spending

P.L. 109-129: Stem Cell Therapeutic and Research Act of 2005

• Authorizes the C.W. Bill Young Cell Transplantation Program

 Provides for the collection and maintenance of human cord blood stem cells for the treatment of patients and research

Other Legislation

- S. 2104 American Center for Cures Act of 2005
- Bill would establish the American Center for Cures as a new IC
- Focus of Center would be to promote more rapid translation public and private research into therapies
- Center Director would be presidentially appointed
- Center would administer NIH's technology transfer activities

Other Legislation (cont'd)

NIH Reauthorization

- No bill introduced
- Committee on Energy and Commerce has many competing priorities
