#### 2009-2010 Series Information

- Wilmington, DE: Key Points
  - Racial categories are socio-political constructs and often do not reflect genetic ancestry.
  - Cancer disparities experienced by minorities are largely a result of preventable environmental factors and decreased access to care.
  - Cultural and logistic barriers, particularly language barriers, often impede prompt, accurate treatment and adherence.
  - Each individual has a unique complement of cultural, environmental, biological, and genetic risk factors that coalesce to determine cancer risk.
