Where are we?

- > Operating under a Continuing Resolution
- ➢ Expires Dec. 18
- ≻ FY 2010 funding level

What's next?

- > Omnibus Appropriation Bill?
 - Earmarks must be resolved
- Short-term CR?
- ≻ Long-term CR?
 - Funding level must be decided



New Legislation Introduced HR 6224

- 21st Century Cancer Access to Life-Saving Early Detection, Research and Treatment (ALERT) Act
- Introduced by Rep. Lois Capps on Sept 28
- Companion to Senate bill introduced by Kennedy HR 5861
 - Cancer Centers Assistance for Renovations and Expansion Act
 - Loan program for qualifying cancer centers
 - Introduced by Rep. Kilroy (D-OH) on July 26



Project Cancer Education
